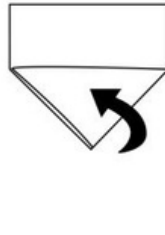
Folding instructions



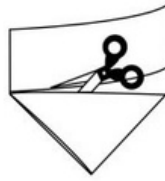
Take one piece of paper



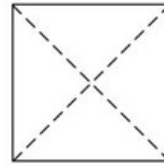
Fold to meet the other corner



Fold the other corner to meet the edge



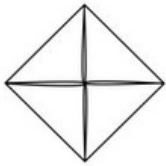
Cut off the section at the top



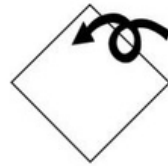
Unfold it to have a square piece of paper



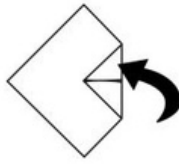
Fold up all four corners so that the points meet in the middle.



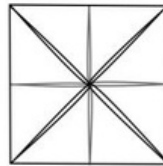
It should look like this when folded



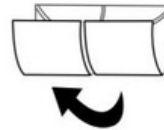
Turn the paper over



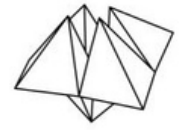
Fold in all four corners so that the points meet in the middle.
